



<u>Amtrak</u> (National Railroad Passenger Corporation) serves more than 500 destinations in 46 states and three Canadian provinces, operating more than 300 trains each day over 21,300 miles of track. Some track sections allow trains to run as fast as 150 mph. In fiscal year 2015, Amtrak served 30.8 million passengers and had \$2.185 billion in revenue, while employing more than 20,000 people. <u>David Clinton</u> is an avid Amtrak enthusiast, and has traveled nearly all of the Amtrak routes, including two which no longer exist. He is a longtime member of the South Shore Model Railway Club, which is one of America's oldest model railroad clubs, having been founded in September 1938 in Quincy. The club is now headquartered in Bare Cove Park in Hingham where it has a large facility including a museum that is open to the public.
